September 2008 — Retired Supreme Court Justice and McConville, Considine attorney Raymond E. Cornelius will be the featured speaker at a continuing legal education (“CLE”) program sponsored by the Monroe County Bar Association on Tuesday, December 9, 2008. Justice Cornelius is a current member and former Dean of the Monroe County Bar Association’s Academy of Law. In 2006 and 2007, Justice Cornelius was a member of delegations to Novgorod, Russia, as part of the Russian American Rule of Law Consortium program, and spoke on the subject of continuing legal education in the United States and expert witness testimony.
